### **Treatment at concessional fee**

**Malarkodi (28)** who was suffered from Rheumatic Mitral Stenosis compounded with Atrial Septal Defect was treated by the expert team of our hospital with a concession of ₹. 50,600/- from the total cost as she was hailing from a poor family.

**Ms. Pushpalatha (60)** who had tear in the aorta which extended into right coronary artery. The expert team of our hospital has conducted a six hours surgery and saved her life under concessional cost.

### **Free Nursing training for the poor girls**



With the support of Tamil Nadu Slum Clearance Board, 25 girls (8th Pass/Fail) were given free training on Emergency and Geriatric Nursing and are working in our hospital as home nursing staff with the salary from ₹. 3900/ to ₹. 4900/-. The second batch were trained and placed in November, 2008

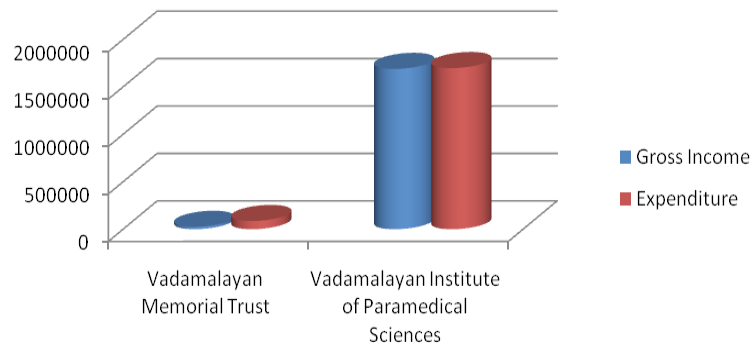
### **Free Medical Centre**
